# **New functionality**



List of new functionality that has been added to this release.

#### Designer

It is now possible to generate a PDF with empty form designs (empty CRFs) with
or without annotations. This functionality allows for all forms in the design or an
individual form to be exported.

#### **Admin**

- It is now possible for study administrators (Study and Site managers) to send reset
  password emails to users that need to reset their password and have forgotten their
  security question.
- The listing of study designs in ODM study data import now shows the version and revision number for each available design.
- A user invited to multiple study sites with one or multiple roles will only receive one
  email message listing all the study sites and roles that the user has been assigned.

# Updated functionality and bug fixes



List of new functionality that has been updated in this release.

- Bugfix: Not possible to enter numbers using the number keys (shift+number) for users with an AZERTY keyboard layout.
- Bugfix: Event status incorrectly shown as 'Ready' for events where all forms have been filled but at least one form contains errors.
- Bugfix: Column headers not enclosed in quotes when column label contains a comma or quotes.
- Bugfix: ViedocMe questionnaires not shown when subject activated with Turkish language

#### **Known limitations**



List of limitations that have been found with this and earlier releases of Viedoc, and will be changed in future releases.

- The export preview feature is heavy to load and might cause the application to feel unresponsive
- Only one (selected) language can be imported from each CDISC ODM file
- Only one (selected) design can be imported from each CDISC ODM file
- When the study workflow is saved, the language in the design settings are lost and have to be reset
- Visibility conditions (entry conditions) cannot be set for activities in common events.
- The next and previous links may not correctly reflect the number of subject filtered in some instances. Going back to subject selection and re-selecting a patient solves the problem.
- Opening a form might fail in some instances when using IE 8.
- Empty CRF's PDF wont display all code list items for radio and checkboxes with many code list items in vertical layout.
- The code list tables for dropdowns are not displayed completely in the CRF PDF if the code list has many items.
